The Andrews Business and Community Alliance (ABCA) consists of members of the business, civic, military and faith communities, elected and appointed officials, congressional staffers and other members of the public sector whose goal is to provide advocacy and support for the mission at AAFB, located on 7,000 acres in Camp Springs, Maryland.

ABCA's principal interests are advancing economic development and improving the quality of life for the residents of Prince George's County while supporting the nation's defense, the men and women of our armed forces and their families.

The Andrews Business and Community Alliance was created and formed under the auspices of the Greater Prince George's Business Roundtable (GPGBR). The Roundtable is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization that desires to bring investment to the County while enhancing the quality of life for its residents.

ABCA relies for its operating funds on membership dues and grants from the State of Maryland and Prince George's County, Maryland. Staff is provided by GPGBR. ABCA is partnered with the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development (DBED) and is a member of the Maryland Military Council. The Prince George's County Council is a key strategic partner in our efforts by providing funds and myriad support.
